Eligibility: All PBWS members may enter up to 2 pieces of art. No size limitations. Please call Camille Rosano at 914-260-8690 with any questions.

Entry Fee: \$30. (plus \$1.50 Cloud Folios administrative fee).

Entry Guidelines: All entries must be made on-line via Cloud Folios at <https://www.cloudfolios.com/exhibitions/167>. If you have not already done so, you must create a free Cloud Folios account and upload your images as a jpeg. Do not show any frame or mat and the image must be correctly oriented, either vertically or horizontally. (You Tube provides various tutorials on how to photograph, crop and edit your art as an image.) Any entries uploaded onto Cloud Folios after April 5th, 2021 will not be accepted.

Eligible Artwork: Watercolors, Acrylics, Inks or Collage made by an artist's own artwork will be accepted. No oils, pastels, charcoal, drawings, photography, prints or giclees. Images should be of your original art only, and not created under instruction or copied from another artist's work. Only your own, original photographs may be used for reference. Paintings that have been exhibited in prior PBWS shows are not eligible. Work must be less than 3 years old.

Juror: We are pleased to announce that Hugh O'Neill will juror our show. Hugh was trained in Ireland and has spent time in France. He is considered one of Ireland's greatest living landscape artists and is a gifted draftsman with a deep understanding of color and tone.
